GUICHET UNIQUE

The *Guichet Unique* welcomes international students on two distinct periods, in September and January, at the <u>Maison des Echanges Internationaux et de la Francophonie in Nantes.</u>

Tutors, students and staff of the « Direction Europe et International » (DEI) ("International Relations Office of Nantes University") welcome **all international students** who have come to Nantes University for a mobility or to enrol.

It is therefore the entry point for international students arriving at the IUT of Nantes. It is <u>mandatory</u> for all international students to go to the *Guichet Unique* upon arrival:

Nantes University is a partner of a number of institutions and organisations, several of which hold an office at the *Guichet Unique* to help students with procedures on site:

- The CROUS (« Centre régional des œuvres universitaires et scolaires »)
- The social worker from the university service of preventive medicine and health protection (Summps)
- A housing assistance information point («Caisse d'Allocations familiales» Studapart)
- A public transport information point (SNCF and TAN)
- The ESN Nantes Autour du Monde society of international students in Nantes

ENROLMENT AT THE IUT OF NANTES

Before registering at the IUT of Nantes, students must pay the CVEC on the following website https://www.messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr/envole/

What is the CVEC?

Each student registered in a first degree course in a higher education institution must obtain, a certificate of payment of the Student and Campus Life Contribution (CVEC) ("Contribution de Vie Étudiante et de Campus (CVEC)"), before enrolling, by paying on the following website (https://cvec.etudiant.gouv.fr/).

If the student doesn't have an account on the website, they must create one in order to pay the CVEC. As an indication, the amount was €103 in 2024.

After going to the Guichet Unique and paying the CVEC, international students must make an appointment with the International Relations Office of the IUT of Nantes (<u>relations-internationales.iutna@univ-nantes.fr</u>) and go there with their complete registration file (office A1/24 – La Fleuriaye Campus)

Documents to put in the registration file:

- The registration form signed and completed at the Guichet Unique
- A recent photograph (less than 2 months old) in ID card format + authorisation form to use the photograph
- Proof of payment of the CVEC (student and campus life contribution). To be downloaded from the website: https://cvec.etudiant.gouv.fr/
- A copy of a valid identity card, passport or residence permit
- Photocopy of the high school diploma transcript
- The tuition fees have to be paid by the student, **by credit card only.** As an indication, in 2024, for a BUT enrolment, the fees amounted to €175.

If the student does not have a credit card and can only pay in cash, they must first go to the Accounting Office (Bureau de l'agence comptable), at the Nantes University Presidency (1 quai de Tourville, 44035 Nantes). NO CASH will be accepted at the IUT!

The student must not forget to make an appointment with the Head of the registration service!

Emplois du temps

As a student, your **timetable** is not fixed and will be different one week to the next, which is why it is essential to check it regularly!

To do this, go on the intranet under the heading "Your webservices" ("Vos Webservices") and then to the sub-category "Timetable, courses, teaching" ("Emploi du temps, cours, pédagogie"). Then click on "Timetable" ("Emplois du temps") and choose your school: "IUT de Nantes". You can then select your group (for example "GEII2 TDA") to view your timetable.



Webmail

As new students at the university, you will soon realise that it is essential to use the Webmail. In fact, you will receive emails every week on all sorts of subjects, from a cancelled or moved lesson, to the week's agenda of activities on campus.

Check this IUT academic mailbox daily because only this e-mail address is used by the administration and teaching staff!



Madoc

The Madoc educational platform enables all teachers to make their course content and multimedia documents available to students online. You can access this online course space via the Nantes University Webservices or by typing the following address: madoc.univ-nantes.fr



Forum

Accessing the Forum couldn't be easier! Go on the intranet under the heading "Yourwebservices" ("Vos webservices") then in the sub-category "Communicate" ("Communiquer"). Once you have clicked on "Forum", a multitude of discussions will appear in which you can take part. You can also click on "Categories" to directly select the subject that interests you, for example: "Classifieds – for sale" ("Petites announces – à vendre"), "School information" ("Infos scolarité") or "News, events, going out in Nantes" ("Actualités, événements, sorties sur Nantes").

ACCOMMODATION

For non-exchange students

ESPACIL residence in Carquefou on La Fleuriaye campus, near the IUT. A 20m2 room costs around €400 including charges

University housing on the Joffre campus in the city centre (near the Chanzy or Léonard de Vinci university residences). You must contact the CROUS directly: https://trouverunlogement.lescrous.fr/

The CROUS offers the following various types of accommodation:

- Rooms in university residences (approximately €254.8/month): 9m2 rooms with individual shower/WC cabin, refrigerator, built-in furniture and communal kitchen.
- 18m2 studios

Informations:

A **guarantor** is mandatory for non-exchange students. A guarantor undertakes to pay the rent on your behalf if you are unable to pay. If you are having difficulty finding a guarantor living in France, there is the Visale guarantee: this is a guarantee granted by Action Logement to people under the age of 30. All procedures can be carried out online on the website www.visale.fr

The **security deposit** is a **deposit** that you pay when you move in. The amount is equal to one month's rent and will be reimbursed on departure if no damage is found.

Loca-Pass : offered by *Action Logement*, this "Pass" is a 0% loan that can be used to finance the security deposit required when you move in. It is available to students under the age of 30. You can apply online www.actionlogement.fr/l-avance-loca-pass

Studapart (https://univ-nantes.studapart.com/fr/), will also act as a guarantor if you use the partner platform to look for accommodation.

For students participating in an exchange program

If you wish to stay in a room in a university residence, you must make the request through the online application before:

- May 15th for students coming for the first semester or for the academic year
- November 15th for students coming for the second semester

Given the limited number of rooms available, not all requests can be met. Your room reservation will be confirmed between June 15th and June 30th for the first semester or the academic year, and between December 10th and 15th for the second semester.

> If you are staying in a university residence, you will have to:

 Pay a security deposit upon your arrival (approximately one month's rent). This deposit will be refunded on departure if no damage is found.

Loca-Pass: offered by Action Logement, this "Pass" is a 0% loan that can be used to finance the security deposit required of tenants when they move into the accommodation. It is available to students under the age of 30. You can apply online www.actionlogement.fr/l-avance-loca-pass

Studapart (https://univ-nantes.studapart.com/fr/), will also act as guarantor if you use the partner platform to look for accommodation.

- Provide proof of accommodation insurance (fire, water damage, etc.)
- Find a guarantor (for students outside the exchange program only) *see section "For students outside the exchange program".

LOKAVIZ (https://www.lokaviz.fr/) is a CROUS platform dedicated to private accommodation offers.

OPENING A BANK ACCOUNT

Opening a bank account is strongly recommended for the management of your budget (payment of your bills by direct debit, reimbursement of medical expenses, etc.) and is mandatory if you want to receive housing assistance from the CAF. Ask your usual bank if it is associated with a French network, as this may make your transactions easier.

To open a bank account in France, you will need to provide the following documents:

- your school certificate or your student card from Nantes University
- an identity document (passport or ID card)
- a copy of your visa for non-European students
- proof of residency in France (certificate of residence from the CROUS for students living in a university residence, invoice, rent receipt, etc.)

Opening an account is generally free. However, you may be charged for certain services (credit card, overdraft authorisation, etc.). Some banks will charge you a small fee if you use a different ATM than their own.

HEALTH AND SOCIAL SECURITY PROCE-

You are a student of European nationality

If you have a valid **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)** for the duration of your stay, you do not need to join the French National Health Insurance (also known as the "Assurance Maladie"). To claim reimbursement for treatment, you must attach the following documents:

- a copy of your European Health Insurance card (front and back)
- the treatment sheet issued by the doctor
- a bank details form
- a certificate of enrolment for the current academic year

and send these documents to the following address: CPAM de Loire-Atlantique - 9, rue Gaëtan-Rondeau - 44958 Nantes CEDEX 9

If you do not have a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or if it is no longer valid, you must join the National Health Insurance (https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr).

You are a student from outside the European Union

You must join the National Health Insurance (https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr).

You are a student from Quebec

You must have the RAMQ form allowing you to be covered for the duration of your stay. If you do not have it you must join the National Health Insurance. (https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr).

ZOOM ON THE REIMBURSEMENT OF YOUR MEDICAL FEES

Please note that the social security reimburses 70% of the cost of your consultation if you declare a general practitioner. If you do not declare a general practitioner, you will only be reimbursed up to 30%.

To complete the reimbursement of your medical fees, it is advised to subscribe to a **supplementary health insurance** policy (**also known as "Mutuelle"**), especially in the event of hospitalisation. You have to pay for it but it is not mandatory. You should always consult your general practitioner before making an appointment with a specialist in order to be reimbursed.

«Solidarity Supplement Health Insurance -C2S»:

Under certain conditions (modest income), you can benefit from the Solidarity Supplement Health Insurance. It is a free service which you can apply for via your personal Ameli account.

Consultations are free but you must make an appointment: general medicine, nutrition, gynaecology, psychiatry, addiction, nursing, vaccinations, etc.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE FINDING A JOB

European students have the same rights as French citizens. The legal full-time working week in France is 35 hours.

Foreign students from outside the European Union can work up to 964h a year or around 20h a week (so 60% of the annual working time) if they have a "long-stay visa – used as a residence permit" (VLS-TS). Beyond this period, their work contract must be part of heir studies and the employer must apply for a temporary work permit.

Except for **Algerian students** who must apply for a Provisional Work Permit (TPA) (*"Autorisation Provisoire de Travail – APT"*). For further information: https://www.campusfrance.org/fr/work-in-france-demande-autorisation-provisoire-travail-en-ligne
